

COOKIE POLICY

The website of the Fundació Institut de Recerca en Energia de Catalunya (IREC) uses its own and third-party cookies to ensure its proper functioning and to collect information about Users' browsing activity. Non-essential cookies will only be activated following your consent via the cookie banner/panel. IREC is responsible for the processing of personal data collected through the forms available on this Website.

1. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are text files that are downloaded to the User's terminal device (computer, tablet, mobile phone, etc.) when they access certain web pages. Cookies allow, amongst other things, information about a User's browsing habits or their device to be stored and retrieved and, depending on the information they contain and how the device is used, they may be used to recognise the User.

Cookies are essential to the functioning of the Internet and provide benefits in the delivery of interactive services, facilitating browsing and the usability of the Website. Cookies cannot damage your device and, in return, having them enabled helps to identify and resolve errors.

2. TYPES OF COOKIES

By management and ownership:

- **Own cookies:** These are sent to the User's terminal device from a computer or domain managed by the publisher itself, from which the service requested by the User is provided.
- **Third-party cookies:** These are sent to the User's terminal device from a computer or domain that is not managed by the publisher but by another entity that processes the data obtained through the cookies.

By retention period:

- **Session cookies:** Designed to collect and store data whilst the User accesses a web page. They are typically used to store information that is only relevant for providing the service requested by the User on a single occasion.
- **Persistent cookies:** The data remains stored on the terminal device and can be accessed and processed by the party responsible for the cookie for a defined period, which may range from a few minutes to several years.

By purpose:

- **Technical or necessary cookies:** These enable the User to browse a website, platform or application and to use the various options or services available on it, including those used by the publisher to allow the management and operation of the web page and to enable its functions and services — for example, identifying the session, accessing restricted areas, remembering items in an order, carrying out a purchase, submitting a registration or event participation request, storing content for the broadcast of video or sound, or sharing content via social media.
- **Analytical cookies:** These allow the party responsible for them to monitor and analyse the behaviour of Users on the websites to which they are linked, including quantifying the impact of advertisements. Information collected through this type of cookie is used to measure activity on websites, applications or platforms and to build browsing profiles of Users of those sites, applications and platforms, with the aim of making improvements based on analysis of usage data.
- **Social media cookies:** Stored by social media providers to enable sharing buttons and plug-ins, and to track the use of those services.
